



# Postgraduate Studies and Scientific Research Sector Data




# Distribution of academic and emerging academic staff members



# The number of postgraduate national and foreign students registered for Diploma, Master and Doctor of Philosophy degrees from 1/1/2018 to 1/4/2021



### The number of students enrolled in the Pre-Master from 1/1/2018 to 1/4/2021


















